"There are no particular concerns however given the history of use on this site the above ground self contained garden beds are required."

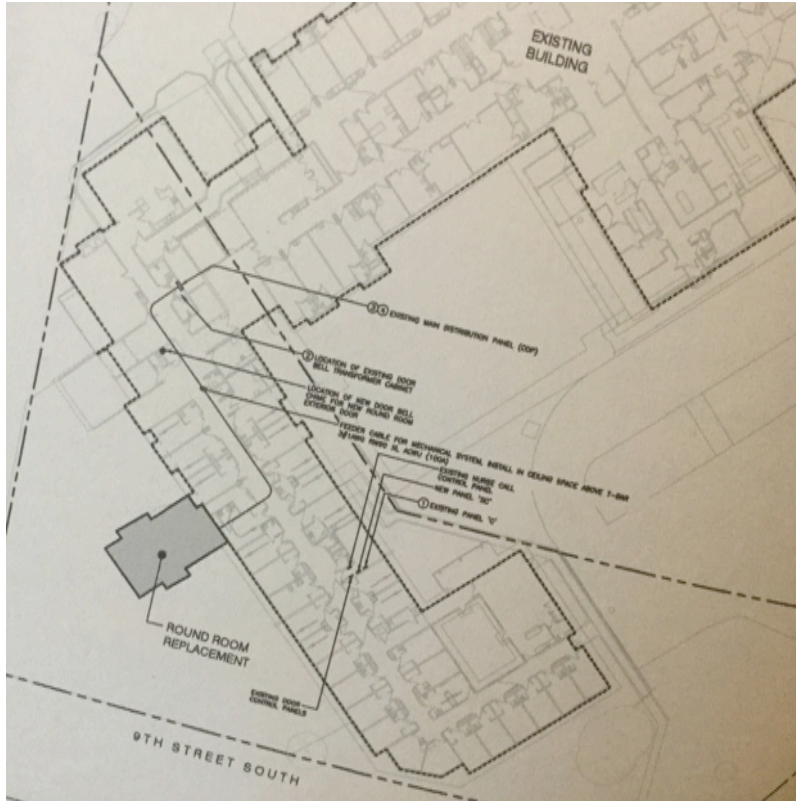
